

Artificial Intelligence Advisory Board Conflict of Interest Register

It is the responsibility of each member to inform the Chair or Secretariat of the Artificial Intelligence Advisory Board (the Board) at the Department of the Premier and Cabinet of an actual conflict, potential or perceived conflict of interest prior to any meeting, consistent with the Board Terms of Reference and Code of Conduct. This can be done verbally or in writing at any time, but it is important that it occurs before discussion of a relevant meeting agenda item.

This Register is used by the Board Secretariat to record conflicts of interest brought to the attention of the Chair of the Board. The 'Conflicts of Interest Declaration' is a standing agenda item at all meetings of the Board.
