

WA Firearms Safety Training Course – Theory. How to Enrol Guide.

Who needs to undertake the Firearm Safety Training Course? (s.166 Firearms Act 2024).

All new applicants for a Firearm Authority must complete the WA Firearms Safety Training Course - Theory as part of their application process.

This requirement also applies to Authorised Persons who do not possess their own firearm authority.

The WA Firearm Safety Training Course - Theory covers a range of topics including legislative requirements, including the safe handling of a firearm. The online WA Firearms Safety Training Course – Theory is hosted by Central Regional TAFE.

How to Enrol

Step 1: Get your Unique Student Identifier (USI)

Your Unique Student Identifier (USI) is a one-time application that generates a unique combination of letters and numbers, which is required to log in to access the WA Firearms Safety Training Course - Theory through Central Regional TAFE.


Step 2: Complete your online enrolment


