

## **General Information**

#### **Eligibility**

- · You **must** be 18 years of age or older.
- You must have been living in Western
   Australia (WA) continuously for the 12 months
   immediately preceding this application.
- You must have a statement from a doctor or psychologist certifying that you have received appropriate clinical treatment in relation to your sex or gender.
- **If** you are a Restricted Person, you **must** have the approval of a Supervisory Authority. See page 2

#### Multiple sex or gender changes

You can only apply for a document acknowledging your change of sex or gender in Western Australia:

- once in any 12 month period and
- three times as an adult.

#### Successful application

If your application is successful, your change of sex or gender will be recorded within the Register of Births, Deaths and Marriages and you will be issued with an acknowledgment document.

#### **Supporting documentation**

- · Your birth certificate **must** be provided.
- You must provide at least two (2) separate forms of documentary evidence that you have been living in WA continuously for the 12 months immediately preceding this application.
- You must have a statement from a doctor or psychologist certifying that you have received appropriate clinical treatment in relation to your sex or gender.
- Provide at least three (3) forms of identification
   (ID) with this application.
   See page 3
- You must provide photo ID.
   See pages 3, 6, 7
- If you are applying in person, **original** documents **must** be provided.
- For postal applications, clear and legible copies must be provided.
- Proof of all previous sex or gender changes must be provided.
- Overseas documents must be translated into English by an accredited NAATI translator located in Australia. Overseas translations will not be accepted.
- Any other additional documents requested by the Registry.

#### **Checklist**

Incomplete applications will cause delays and may be refused. A checklist has been included to assist you in meeting all the requirements prior to submitting this application.

## **Restricted Person**

If you are a Restricted Person, as listed below, you are required to obtain the approval of your Supervisory Authority before submitting your application.

- **High risk serious offender** the Chief Executive Officer of the department principally assisting in the administration of the *High Risk Serious Offenders Act 2020* Part 4 Division 2.
- **Detainee** the Chief Executive Officer as defined in the *Young Offenders Act 1994* Section 3.
- Person subject to an early release order the Prisoner's Review Board established under the *Sentence Administration Act 2003* Section 102(1).
- **Prisoner** the Chief Executive Officer as defined in the *Prisons Act 1981* Section 3(1).
- Officer in the department principally assisting in the administration of the provision of the *Act* under which the supervised offender is supervised or monitored.
- Supervised young offender Supervised Release Review Board established under the Young Offenders Act 1994 Section 151(1).

# **Required Declarant**

A Required Declarant in WA is a:

- High risk serious offender.
- Detainee.
- Person subject to an early release order.
- Prisoner.
- Supervised offender.
- Supervised young offender.
- Reportable offender.

You **must** advise the Registrar by completing the declaration on page 8.

# **Privacy & Disclosure**

Information requested on this form is collected under the provisions of the *Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act 1998* and forms the basis to determine your eligibility to apply for a document acknowledging your change of sex or gender.

Information held by the Registry may be provided to government and non-government organisations for the purpose of statistical and medical research and to law enforcement agencies as well as other uses provided for by law.

Any documents provided with this application may have their authority verified through an approved online verification service.

Documents issued by this office may also be verified by other organisations using this service.

### **Identification**

You **must** provide at least **three (3)** forms of ID from the following lists:

- One document from List 1, 2 and 3 or
- One from List 1 & two from List 2 or
- Two from List 2 & one from List 3.

#### Note:

- All forms of identification must be current (not expired).
- Documents from List 3 must show your current residential address and have an issue or expiry date displayed.
- Bank statements, utility accounts or rates notices must have been issued within the last six months.

- Overseas passport with current Australian Entry Permit.
- Security or Crowd Controller Licence (Australian).
- Student identity document or statement of enrolment issued by an educational institution, including Tertiary (include photo and/or signature).
- · Working with Children Check card.

#### List 3 – Proof of your current residential status

- · Driver's Licence Renewal Notice.
- Motor Vehicle Registration.
- Financial institution statement.
- · Property lease or tenancy agreement.
- Shire/water rates notice.
- School or other educational report or certificate less than 12 months old.
- Utility account (gas, electricity, phone etc).

# **Proof of Residency in WA**

You must have been living in WA continuously for the 12 months immediately preceding this application. Evidence is required.

#### How to prove you have lived in WA

- A **minimum of two (2)** separate documents showing your **current residential address** (not PO Box) and, where applicable, all previous WA addresses within the last 12 months.
- Evidence should not be older than 12 months (except your WA Driver's Licence).
- The Registry will not accept any documents that do not have a **date of issue** displayed.

#### Note

- The Registry may make further enquiries about your living arrangements prior to this application.
- The Registrar can refuse your application if you do not meet the requirements.




