



Family and Domestic Violence Lived Experience Advisory Group

Communique Meeting 03/2025 – 15 July 2025

The Family and Domestic Violence Lived Experience Advisory Group (Advisory Group) held its third meeting at Boorloo on 15 July 2025. The meeting commenced with an Acknowledgement of Country, followed by a reflection and minute of silence to honour and remember all victim-survivors of family and domestic violence, including those who did not survive.

The Advisory Group received an update on key milestones and upcoming activity in the System Reform Plan. This was followed by a focus on the redevelopment of the Common Risk Assessment and Risk Management Framework and the development of the Aboriginal Family Violence Risk Assessment Tool. The purpose of the session was to draw on the knowledge, experience, and expertise of the Advisory Group to ensure practitioners have the right guidance to screen for, assess and manage family and domestic violence risk, and to gauge whether the draft tools reflect and support those expectations.

The Advisory Group continued discussions on developing their annual workplan, highlighting the opportunity for this to be aligned to government priorities and balanced with action where they can make a difference during their tenure. The Advisory Group acknowledged the momentum being built over the first half of the year and their keenness for timely, impactful work as a group.
