



Earlier Intervention and Family Support (EIFS)

Having a strong family that feels safe and secure is important to everyone – especially our young ones. Sometimes things can happen that make it hard to stay on track.

The Regional Family Support Hub (The Hub) is an EIFS Service available to families in regional and remote areas to help keep them safe, strong and together.

The Hub is available to families and some young people living in the East Kimberley, Pilbara and South West.



The Hub

The Hub offers three types of service support depending on your needs.

Support Network

- For families facing big challenges, and young people aged 18 to 25 who have had a care experience
- Connects families to a broad network of local support services
- Families and young people can refer themselves

Community Intensive Case Management

- For families who are facing bigger challenges and want to work together with a service provider to sort things out.
- Families must be referred by Department of Communities to access the service.

Regional Intensive Support

- Helps families find ways to keep their kids safe at home or reunite with their kids if they have gone into care.
- It's culturally safe and offers practical support to help parents and kids strengthen their relationships and build safe, strong connections within their local community.
- Available to families already involved with Department of Communities.
