1 Welcome and Agenda

Issues 10,11, 38, I2025.6 and I2025.7 will proceed to drafting.

Following the meeting, EPWA provided an updated copy of the HTR meeting workbook, reflecting the outcomes of the 07 August 2025 meeting. This updated workbook was shared with members out of session and will be published with these Minutes as a record of the meeting.

5 New Issues for HTR List

• Mr Van Den Dolder raised an issue regarding the definition of common coupling, and suggested rewording that to cover all NSPs.

Mr Robinson noted the new issue as I2025.07.

6 Next Steps

The Chair outlined the expectation that drafting instructions for most outstanding issues would be provided by the September meeting. She asked whether members preferred to review the Amending Rules in parcels, or altogether at the end.

 Mr Stephens asked for further time to consider but thought that providing all the rules together so they can be assessed in their entirety and for consistency would be the better option.
