

Western Australian Building and Construction Consultative Committee (BCC Committee)

Key Outcomes of Meeting

2 December 2025

- The BCC Committee Chair reported on the Strategic Plan Refresh Workshop (5 November 2025) which reviewed progress against the 2022–2025 Plan and identified areas for continued work and future advice. Members provided feedback during the session on a draft of the BCC Committee Strategic Plan for the period 2026 to 2028, with a final draft of that plan expected to be endorsed by the BCCC and referred to the Minister for Industrial relations for consideration in the first quarter of 2026.
- The BCC Committee reviewed a close to final draft of the proposed Supplier Voluntary Code of Conduct (Code) for procurement on government construction projects. Further amendments to the Code are currently under consideration by the BCC Committee.
- The Minister for Industrial Relations endorsed the “Western Australian Building and Construction Consultative Committee – White Card System Review and Survey Results” Report, a key deliverable of the current BCC Committee Strategic Plan, and the implementation plan for its recommendations. A copy has been provided to the Minister for Skills and TAFE.
- The Minister also approved the lodgement of the BCC Committee’s Case for Change for CPCWHS1001 – Prepare to Work Safely in the Construction Industry with BuildSkills. This has been submitted with the Secretariat.
- The BCC Committee considered a draft of the State of Affairs report, which provides an overview of the current culture in the Western Australian commercial construction sector (and wider construction industry). The Minister has requested the BCC Committee review the future opportunities listed in the report and provide the Minister advice on 6 to 12 specific actionable recommendations.
- The Secretariat provided a brief update on the Licensing unlicensed trades project however due to time constraints the item is to be circulated out-of-session for review and/or endorsement by the BCC Committee.
- The 2026 BCC Committee meetings are yet to be scheduled.
