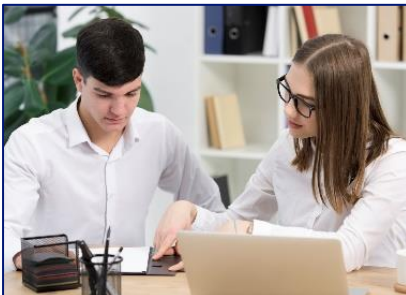


Public Trustee

What does “investing money” mean?



Investing money means using money to make more money.



The Public Trustee is your **plenary administrator**.



This means we look after your money and make sure it is used in the best way.



This can include investing your money, so it stays safe and earns more money over time.

Why do you invest my money?



When your money is invested, it can be used to earn you more money.



We decide if we can invest your money based on how much money you have, and your age.



We look at what you need to pay for now and if you want to buy or do something special in the future.



We put your money in the **Common Account**, which is the Public Trustee's bank account.

How do you invest my money?



The Common Account has a very large amount of money in it. By adding your money to one big account, it can earn more interest.



Experts give advice on the best ways the Public Trustee can invest money it has.



This helps us make safe choices about your money.



If you have lots of money we can invest your money in the Public Trustee Investment Funds (PTIFs) or property.

Your statement shows how much money you have and how much extra money you have earned as interest.

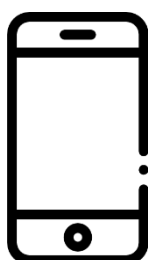

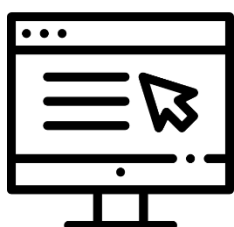
