



Western Australia hosts world-class gold deposits

- Western Australia's gold production for 2024–25 was 6.7 Moz, worth over AU\$29 billion

Mining activity

- During 2025, first gold was poured from mines at the Widgeemooltha (Auric Mining), Devon (Matsa Resources), Phillips Find (Horizon Minerals), Boorara (Horizon Minerals), and Murchison (Meeka Metals) Projects
- Northern Star acquired the Hemi Project on 5 May 2025. This was the biggest acquisition deal ever done in Australia with an acquisition cost of AU\$5 Billion. Hemi represents one of the largest undeveloped gold projects in a tier-1 jurisdiction
- Several major projects are now at Feasibility and Pre-Feasibility stage including the Katanning (Ausgold), Apollo Hill (Saturn Metals), Lady Julie (Magnetic Resources), Dalgarna (Ramelius Resources), Garden Gully (New Murchison), Menzies (Brightstar Resources), Rebecca and Roe (Ramelius Resources), Youanmi Gold (Rox Resources), Feysville and Mandilla (Astral Resources), and Lady Ida (Lamerton) Projects
- The Havieron Project (Greatland Gold) is currently under development

Resources

- Significant mineral resource upgrades have been announced for the Golden Mile + Kanowna + Jundee (Northern Star), Murchison (Westgold Resources), Kundana/Mungari (Evolution Mining), Mt Gibson (Capricorn Metals), Kambalda Gold (Westgold Resources), Bullabulling (M16 Resources), Plutonic (Catalyst Metals), Minyari Dome (Antipa Minerals), Kambalda – St Ives (Gold Fields), Lady Julie (Magnetic Resources), and Dalgarna (Ramelius Resources) Projects

Exploration

- Significant gold intercepts continue to be announced from several projects in the State including – Minyari Dome (Antipa Minerals), Garden Gully (New Murchison), Kundana – White Flag (Evolution Minerals), Kambalda Gold (Westgold Resources), Central Norseman (Pantoro), Neptune–Bryah (Tambourah Metals), and Lady Ida (Lamerton) Projects
- Several gold discoveries were announced during 2025 including at the Island Gold (Caprice Resources), Comet Vale (Gorilla Gold), Mt Ida (Ballard Mining), and Barwidgee (Yandal Resources) Projects
