



Western Australian Building and Construction Consultative Committee (BCC Committee)

Key Outcomes of Meeting

11 February 2026

- The BCC Committee endorsed the proposed Voluntary Supplier Code of Conduct (Code) for procurement on government construction projects and has referred it to the Minister for Industrial relations for consideration. The Code represents the culmination of a substantial body of work undertaken by the BCC Committee over an extended period, including facilitated workshops, deliberations during regular BCC Committee meetings, and targeted consultation with industry stakeholders and government agencies.

In preparing the final version of the Code, members have worked collaboratively and in good faith to resolve complex issues relating to safety, training, workforce inclusion, ethics, industrial relations and environmental responsibility.

The Code provides a clear and consistent framework to support cultural and behavioural improvements across the commercial construction sector on projects of significant value (greater than \$100 million), and that it complements the Government's broader objectives under the Safe and Fair Procurement Reform Package.

- The BCC Committee considered a draft BCC Committee Strategy for 2026 to 2028. Members provided feedback during the session with a final draft of that plan expected to be endorsed by the BCC Committee and referred to the Minister for Industrial relations for consideration in the first half of 2026.
- The BCC Committee discussed the tabled draft future opportunities associated with the State of Affairs report, a report which provides an overview of the current culture in the Western Australian commercial construction sector (and wider construction industry). Several of the future opportunities were endorsed by the BCC Committee and the Chair indicated his intent to discuss these further with the Minister for Industrial Relations and seek her guidance on next steps.
- The next BCC Committee meeting is scheduled for Tuesday 2 June 2026.
