## **PREVENTION NOTICE**

**Person to whom this Prevention Notice is issued:**

**Minesite Recycling Pty Ltd (ACN 128 335 893)**

In its capacity as occupier of Lot 51 Laverton-Leonora Rd LEONORA WA 6438, Legal description Lot 51 on Plan 189395.

**Premises (the Premises) to which this Prevention Notice relates:**

Lot 51 Laverton–Leonora Road, Leonora WA 6438, being Lot 51 on Plan 189395, as defined by the coordinates in Appendix 2.

**Reasons for which this Prevention Notice is issued:**

This Notice is issued under sections 73A(1)(a) and 73A(1)(b) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to Minesite Recycling Pty Ltd, the occupier of the Premises subject to Works Approval W6600/2021/1 (granted under section 54 of the EP Act), because I reasonably believe that the uncontrolled storage of hazardous and controlled wastes at the Premises is causing, or is likely to cause, pollution, and that waste has been discharged or deposited at the Premises otherwise than in accordance with a works approval or licence.

On 3 February 2026, officers from the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (the Department) conducted an inspection of the Premises and identified that large volumes of unauthorised hazardous and controlled wastes had been accepted and stored without containment. Further, wastes were not stored or managed in accordance with Conditions 6 and 7 of Works Approval W6600/2021/1.

Large-scale hydrocarbon spills were observed during the site inspection, confirming an active pathway for contamination of soil and groundwater. In the absence of effective containment or controls, the activity presents an unacceptable risk of ongoing pollution.

I am satisfied that because:

Minesite Recycling Pty Ltd is the occupier of the Premises, and you are the appropriate person to whom this Notice should be given.

**Requirements of this Notice:**

1. From the date of being given this Notice, the Person to whom this Notice is given must cease accepting any waste onto the Premises, other than scrap metal, until advised in writing by the issuing Inspector or Authorised Person, or a Part V licence authorises the acceptance of such waste.
2. From the date of being given this Notice, the Person to whom this Notice is given must cease landfilling any waste at the premises other than which meets the conditions of works approval W6600/2021/1.
3. From the date of being given this Notice, the Person to whom this Notice is given shall only use the baler on scrap metal free of contaminants.
4. The Person to whom this Notice is given must remove all liquid and solid wastes specified in Column 1 of Table 1 within the corresponding timeframes specified in Column 2 to a suitably authorised facility.

**Table 1:**

<b>Waste Type</b>	<b>Time frame to remove</b>
Used Aerosol cans	Within 30 days of being given this Notice
Used batteries	Within 30 days of being given this Notice
Grease	Within 45 days of being given this Notice
Oily Sludges and Oil Filters	Within 45 days of being given this Notice
Waste oil	Within 60 days of being given this Notice
Oily water and Hydrocarbon mixtures	Within 90 days of being given this Notice
Fire Extinguishers	Within 110 days of being given this Notice
Treated timber	Within 120 days of being given this Notice
Contaminated soil	Within 120 days of being given this Notice
Tyres	Within 120 days of being given this Notice
Flock	Within 180 days of being given this Notice
PVC and Polypipe's	Within 220 days of being given this Notice

5. The Person to whom this Notice is given must, every 30 days from the date of being given this Notice, provide the following information to the issuing Inspector or Authorised Person until such time that all waste is removed from the Premises as required by Requirement 4 of this notice:
  - a) The type and total mass (tonnes) and volume (m<sup>3</sup>) of waste removed from the Premises under Requirement 4 of this Notice.
  - b) The details of the authorised premises where the waste was taken, and copies of any controlled waste tracking forms and/or disposal docketts.
  - c) Where waste was transported to more than one authorised Premises, the mass (tonnes) and volume (m<sup>3</sup>) of waste taken to each authorised Premises.
6. The requirements and timeframes stipulated in this Notice may be amended by an issuing Inspector or Authorised Person in writing on application by Minesite Recycling Pty Ltd or their authorised representative, with reasonable justification.

**Important Information:**

A PERSON WHO IS BOUND BY THIS PREVENTION NOTICE AND WHO DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THIS NOTICE COMMITS AN OFFENCE UNDER THE *ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1986*.

Under section 103 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*:

- a person who is aggrieved by a requirement contained in this prevention notice may within 21 days of being given this notice lodge with the Minister for Environment an appeal in writing setting out the grounds of that appeal; and
- any other person who disagrees with a requirement contained in this prevention notice may within 21 days of the making of that requirement lodge with the Minister for Environment an appeal in writing setting out the grounds of that appeal.

PENDING THE DETERMINATION OF AN APPEAL REFERRED TO ABOVE, THE RELEVANT REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED IN THIS PREVENTION NOTICE CONTINUE TO HAVE EFFECT.

Note that under section 118 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* that each person who is a director or who is concerned in the management of the body corporate may be taken to have also committed the same offence.

## Appendix 1: Definitions

### In this Notice, unless the contrary intention appears

**'Authorised person'** means a person or member of a class of persons appointed under section 87(1) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*.

**'Contaminant'** means a polluting or poisonous substance that makes something impure

**'Days'** means all days including weekends and / or public holidays unless otherwise defined in the Notice.

**'Department'** means the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation.

**'Discharge'** means in relation to waste or other matter—as including depositing it or allowing it to escape, or causing, permitting, or failing to prevent it from being discharged, deposited, or allowed to escape.

**'EP Act'** means the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (WA).

**'Person' to whom this notice is given'** means Minesite Recycling Pty Ltd (ACN 128 3353 893) holds Works Approval W6600/201/1 under Part V of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* WA (EP Act).

**'Premises'** means **Lot 51 Laverton-Leonora Rd LEONORA WA 6438 Legal description - Lot 51 on Plan 189395** , as defined by the coordinates in Appendix 2.

**'Provide in writing'** means includes by email with an authorised signature.

**'Inspector'** for the purposes of correspondence means.
