Purpose of This Information Sheet

- This information sheet explains how to access and enrol in the WA Firearms Safety Training Course – Theory.
- The course is delivered online by Central Regional TAFE (TAFE) and is a required step for certain firearm related applications under Western Australian firearms laws.


How to Enrol

Step 1: Get a Unique Student Identifier (USI)

- Before you can enrol in the WA Firearms Safety Training Course – Theory, you must have a Unique Student Identifier (USI).
- A USI is a reference number made up of letters and numbers. It is required to access nationally recognised training in Australia, including courses delivered by Central Regional TAFE.
- If you do not already have a USI, you can apply for one online at: www.usi.gov.au

- You should obtain your USI before starting the enrolment process with Central Regional TAFE.

Step 2: Complete Your Online Enrolment

- Once you have your Unique Student Identifier (USI), you can enrol in the WA Firearms Safety Training Course – Theory through Central Regional TAFE.


