



Family and Domestic Violence Lived Experience Advisory Group

Communique Meeting 05/2026 – 5 February 2026

The Family and Domestic Violence Lived Experience Advisory Group (Advisory Group) held its fifth meeting at Walyalup on 5 February 2026. The meeting commenced with an Acknowledgement of Country, followed by a moment of reflection and a minute of silence to honour and remember all victim-survivors of family and domestic violence, including those who did not survive.

The Advisory Group received a further update on the development of the Monitoring and Evaluation Framework which underpins the Impact Evaluation of the System Reform Plan. The purpose of the session was to test the appropriateness of the draft survey and interview questions that will be asked of victim-survivors, prior to seeking ethics approval.

The Advisory Group was also engaged to discuss how people impacted by family and domestic violence in Western Australia can be better supported to stay in their own home safely, or to access appropriate safe accommodation. The insights gathered will help shape recommendations to improve safe accommodation options and supports available to people impacted by violence.
