Why go on the Banned Drinkers Register (BDR)

We know it's not just about the booze. Sometimes drinking can be a way to cope with life and feel normal – but it doesn't have to be.

Going grog-free can kick off a new start. The BDR can help you:

- take a break from drinking
- feel more in control
- support your family and kids
- build a stronger, healthier life

What it means for you

When you are on the BDR:

- you cannot buy takeaway alcohol
- you cannot have alcohol with you
- police can take alcohol from you
