



Western Australian Building and Construction Consultative Committee (BCC Committee)

Key Outcomes of Meeting

2 June 2026

- BCC Committee Members received a presentation from the Director General, Department of Local Government, Industry Regulation and Safety (LGIRS) outlining its regulatory role in supporting the Western Australian building and construction sector, including the Director General's strategic alignment to prioritise services that deliver the greatest impact to industry.
- Members endorsed the proposed Workplan to support implementation of the BCCC Strategic Plan 2026–2028.
- The BCC Committee noted the *Voluntary Code of Conduct for Government Suppliers* has received approval from the Minister for Industrial Relations and broad government support. Members acknowledged the significant body of work undertaken to progress the Code and agreed to focus next on developing criteria for pilot project selection and evaluation. The Secretariat will organise a meeting with government agencies involved in the piloting of projects.
- Members endorsed the condensed *State of Affairs Report into Industry Culture* and expanded government opportunities and a copy will be forwarded to the Minister for Industrial Relations for noting.
- The BCC Committee received a presentation from UnionsWA on the gender equality in male-dominated industries project. The presentation strongly aligned with the findings of the *State of Affairs Report*.
- The BCCC Committee Secretariat will be meeting with BuildSkills on 4 June 2026 to discuss the status of the Case for Change relating to CPCWHS1001 *Prepare to work safely in the construction industry* (White Card).
- Members discussed the licensing of additional construction trades and agreed to establish a sub-working group to determine priority trades for licensing and develop a paper for referral to the Minister for Industrial Relations to brief the Minister for Commerce and Minister for Skills and TAFE. The Secretariat will organise a discussion with LGIRS Building and Energy Directorate.
- The BCC Committee noted and supported the upcoming study tour of the Chair and Secretariat in mid-June 2026 and looked forward to the report of the outcomes of the tour.
- BCC Committee members terms were recently extended to 30 April 2029.
- The next BCC Committee meeting is scheduled for Tuesday 1 September 2026.
