



Family and Domestic Violence Lived Experience Advisory Group

Communique Meeting 07/26 – 26 May 2026

The Family and Domestic Violence Lived Experience Advisory Group (Advisory Group) held its seventh meeting at Boorloo on 26 May 2026. The meeting commenced with an Acknowledgement of Country, followed by a moment of reflection and a minute of silence to honour and remember all victim-survivors of family and domestic violence, including those who did not survive.

The Advisory Group reviewed and refined its strategic priorities, informed by the 15 April 2026 workshop and a 'sphere of influence' working document. The alignment of the strategic priorities to the System Reform Plan and other Government priorities was considered. Members identified five key pillars to be further developed to guide the annual workplan.

The Advisory Group discussed the tenure of members and agreed in-principle that a staggered extension would support the ongoing establishment of the Advisory Group and strengthen succession planning. Members will be invited to nominate their preferred extension period, which will inform a formal Western Australian State Cabinet process for the reappointment of members.
