This class exemption relates to the transitional supply of a prescribed plastic item listed in Table 1 where that prescribed plastic item:

- has a current application before the Australasian Bioplastics Association (ABA) and is awaiting certification under the Australian Composting Standards (AS4736:2006 or AS5810:2010); and/or
- has a current and valid EN13432 composting or TUV OK compost HOME certification*.

Interpretation

In this Exemption Notice:

- (a) the words 'including', 'includes' and 'include' in conditions mean "including but not limited to", and similar, as appropriate;
- (b) where any word or phrase is given a defined meaning, any other part of speech or other grammatical form of that word or phrase has a corresponding meaning;
- (c) any reference to an Australian or other standard, guideline, or code of practice in this Exemption Notice:
 - (i) if dated, refers to that version; and
 - (ii) if not dated, refers to the latest version and therefore may be subject to change over time;
- (d) unless specified otherwise, any reference to a section of an Act refers to that section of the EP Act; and
- (e) unless specified otherwise, all definitions are in accordance with the EP Act. Defined terms can be found in Table 2 of this Exemption Notice.

Conditions

General conditions

- A supplier for the purpose of this Exemption Notice, is a manufacturer, wholesale or retail company that sells or supplies one or more of the prescribed plastic items listed in Table 1 of this Exemption Notice to a purchaser or consumer, and that manufacturer, wholesale or retail company has a valid:
 - a) Australian Company Number (ACN) registered with the Australian Securities and Investments Commission (ASIC) to operate within Australia; or
 - b) Australian Business Number (ABN) registered with the Business Registration Service to operate within Australia.
- 2. A purchaser for the purpose of this Exemption Notice, is a:
 - a) Wholesale company;
 - b) Retail company;
 - c) Registered food or beverage retailer;
 - d) State Government department;
 - e) Local Government agency;
 - f) Incorporated Club or Association;
 - g) Licensed charity;
 - h) Incorporated not-for-profit organisation; or
 - i) School or education facility (early learning, primary, secondary, or tertiary institutions).

that purchases any of the prescribed plastic items listed in Table 1 from a manufacturer, wholesale, or retail company to sell or supply to a customer or consumer.

Supplier Conditions

- 3. To sell or supply a prescribed plastic item(s) listed in Table 1 of this Exemption Notice, a supplier must:
 - a) notify the CEO in writing of their use of this exemption notice. This can be done by emailing plastic-exemptions@dwer.wa.gov.au or via postal mail;
 - notify purchasers of prescribed plastic item(s) listed in Table 1 of this Exemption Notice that the prescribed plastic item(s) has a current application before the ABA and is awaiting certification under Australian Composting Standards;
 - c) notify purchasers of prescribed plastic item(s) listed in Table 1 of this Exemption Notice that the prescribed plastic item(s) has a current and valid EN13432 composting or TUV OK compost HOME certification for the prescribed plastic item being supplied, if applicable;
 - d) at the request of the purchaser or the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (Department), provide written evidence that the prescribed plastic item(s) being supplied has a current application before the ABA and is awaiting certification under Australian Composting Standards; and
 - e) at the request of the purchaser or the Department, provide written evidence that the prescribed plastic item(s) being supplied has a current and valid EN13432 composting or TUV OK compost HOME certification for the prescribed plastic item being supplied, if applicable.

Purchaser Conditions

- 4. To sell or supply a prescribed plastic item(s) listed in Table 1 of this Exemption Notice to a customer or consumer, a purchaser using this Exemption Notice must:
 - a) obtain and keep written evidence that the prescribed plastic item(s) purchased has a current application before ABA and is awaiting certification under the Australian Composting Standards; and
 - b) obtain and keep written evidence that the prescribed plastic item(s) purchased has a current and valid EN13432 composting or TUV OK compost HOME certification for the prescribed plastic item being purchased, if applicable.

Australian Standards certification decision

- 5. Within 7 business days of the date of determination by the ABA for certification under Australian Composting Standards for a prescribed plastic item supplied under this Exemption Notice, the supplier must notify the Department of the outcome.
- 6. If a prescribed plastic item supplied under this Exemption Notice is refused ABA certification made under Australian Composting Standards the supplier must:
 - a) immediately cease selling or supplying the prescribed plastic item which has received a refused determination by the ABA; and
 - notify any purchasers of the prescribed plastic item and instruct them to cease selling or supplying the prescribed plastic item which has received a refused determination by the ABA.

Records

7. A supplier using this Exemption Notice for a prescribed plastic item(s) listed in Table 1 of this Exemption Notice must maintain records of who they sold or supplied a prescribed plastic item(s) to under this Exemption Notice.

Department of Water and Environmental Regulation

- 8. These records must include written evidence that the Exemption Holder has sought certification from the ABA for Australian Composting Standards for each prescribed plastic item being sold or supplied under the Exemption Notice and if applicable written evidence of current and valid EN13432 composting or TUV OK compost HOME certification.
- 9. The records specified under conditions 7 and 8 must be accurate, auditable, legible and;
 - a) if amended, be amended in such a way that the original version(s) and any subsequent amendments remain legible and are capable of retrieval;
 - b) be retained by the Exemption Holder for the duration of the Exemption Notice; and
 - c) be available to be produced to an inspector or the CEO as required.

Non-compliance reporting

- 10. Within 14 business days of becoming aware of any non-compliance with the conditions of this Exemption Notice, a supplier or purchaser using this Exemption Notice for an exemption under the regulations for a prescribed plastic item listed in Table 1 of this Exemption Notice must notify the CEO in writing of that non-compliance and include in that notification the following information:
 - a) which condition was not complied with;
 - b) the time and date when the non-compliance occurred;
 - c) the details and result of any investigation undertaken into the cause of the non-compliance;
 - d) what action has been taken and the date on which it was taken to prevent the non-compliance occurring again; and
 - e) what action will be taken and the date by which it will be taken to prevent the non-compliance occurring again.

Revocation or Variation

11. In accordance with regulation 20(5) of the regulations this exemption notice may be revoked or varied by the CEO at any time by written notice.

END OF CONDITIONS
