Alternatively, you may bring your completed form to our office between 8:30am-4pm (Mon to Fri).

Usually, if you make a valid Will, it revokes any existing Will. If the Public Trustee has not prepared your new Will, it cannot be sure of its legal effect.

Once the Public Trustee receives this form, it will note on its records that you have made a new Will.

If it is therefore not necessary to withdraw the Will currently in the Public Trustee's WA Will Bank.

If you wish to withdraw your Will **do not** complete this form, instead complete a **Request for Copy or Withdrawal of Will by Testator Form**.
