What is an administrator?

- 1. The State Administrative Tribunal decides if a person needs an administrator.
- 2. An administrator is a person who can make financial and property decisions for a person with a decision-making disability.
- 3. Financial and property decisions can be about money, selling things or paying bills.
- 4. An administrator does not make lifestyle decisions.
- 5. Often a family member or friend is someone's administrator.
- 6. If these people are not available, the Public Trustee can be appointed.
- 7. Administrators work at the Public Trustee, they can also be called Trust Managers.
- 8. A Trust Manager working at the Public Trustee office can be contacted on 1300 746 212.
