

Lower Gascoyne River Flow Advice N^o2 2026

Issued by the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation

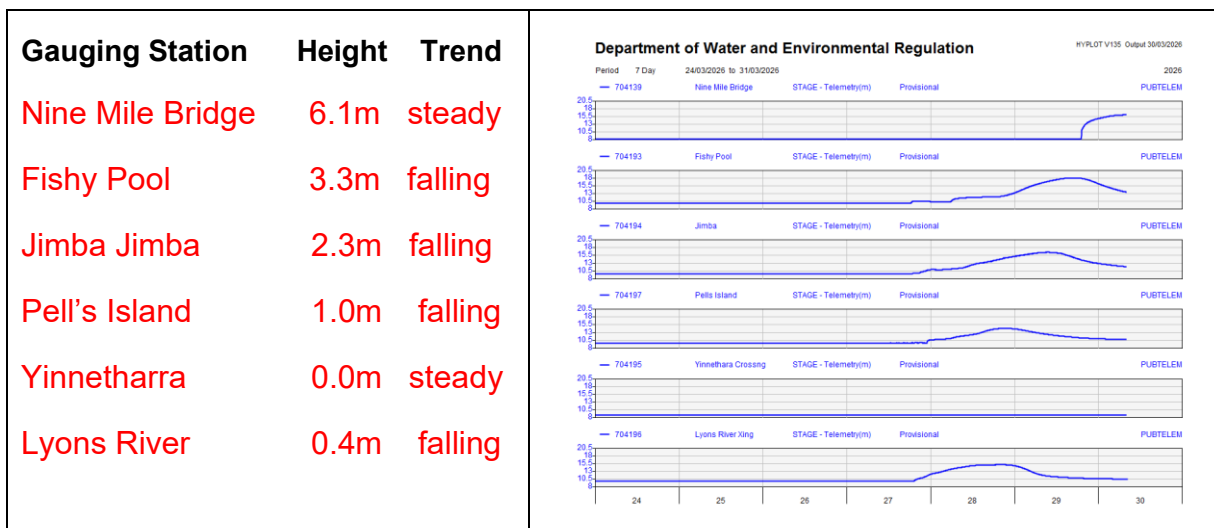
10:00 am Monday the 30th of March 2026

Heavy rainfall in the Lyons and Gascoyne catchments has resulted in river flows at Lyons River Crossing, Jimba Jimba, Pell's Island and Fishy Pool gauging stations.

Lead waters arrived at the 9 Mile Bridge gauging station at approximately 7:00 pm on the 29th of March 2026. Fishy Pool gauging station reached a peak of 8.1 m at 4:00 pm yesterday afternoon.
