### General information

Any proposed changes to the members of a partnership or directors of a body corporate/company must be provided to the Commissioner for Consumer Protection (the Commissioner) for consideration under the requirements of the *Motor Vehicle Dealers Act 1973* and the *Motor Vehicle Repairers Act 2003*. You are reminded that:

- For changes relating to Motor Vehicle Dealer Licences: this form must be submitted 14 days prior to the date on which the change is intended to occur.
- For incoming partners or directors of Motor Vehicle Repair Business Licences: this form must be submitted 14 days prior to the date on which the change is intended to occur.
- For outgoing partners or directors of Motor Vehicle Repair Business Licences: this form must be submitted within 14 days after the cessation.
- If the licensee is a partnership of two or more individuals and you intend to remove partners which will result in the holder becoming a sole trader, you will not be entitled to renew the current licence unless additional partners are added prior to the next renewal.

# Application to change Partners or Directors: MD and MRB

## General information (cont.)

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- The licensee must continue to have sufficient financial resources to comply with the requirements of the relevant industry.
- The Authorisation and Declaration section must be completed by all incoming partners or directors.
- In some instances, partnership licensees may be contacted to provide additional information or documentation regarding incoming and/or outgoing partners.
- If the application to change partners or directors is refused, the licence will cease to have effect 14 days after you have been notified of the decision, unless a further application is lodged within that period.
