A registered electrical fitting worker may make, maintain, repair, alter, assemble, dismantle, connecting or testing electrical machines, electrical appliances, electrical instruments or other electrical equipment, and includes electrical installing work if that work is assembling, maintaining or altering the wiring between electrical components in plant or machinery.

Period of registration

If your application is approved, registration will be granted for a period of one or five years.

Two fees are payable with this application, a registration fee and a non-refundable application fee.
