



Electrical Licensing Board Policy Number ELB - EC/IH002 - 04/2022	
Requirements to be registered as a Nominee to an Electrical Contractor's or In-House Electrical Installing Work Licence	
Purpose	This policy provides the criteria the Electrical Licensing Board require to be met to be registered as a Nominee to an Electrical Contractor's or In-House Electrical Installing Work Licence.
Regulation/s	The following Regulations of the Electricity (Licensing) Regulations 1991 apply to this policy: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Regulation 36 (1), (2) & (3)• Regulation 37 (1)• Regulation 38 (1) & (2)
Policy	<p>An applicant who holds a Western Australian Electrician's Licence, may be registered as a Nominee to an Electrical Contractor's or In-House Electrical Installing Work Licence subject to the applicant meeting one of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) Has completed successfully, within the last two years, the following unit of the Electrical Contractor Training Program:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• WAE200 - Electrical operational Requirements;orb) Has been registered as a Nominee for an Electrical Contractor's Licence, or In-House Electrical Installing Licence in Western Australia within the last two years; or
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">c) Has within the last two years, been an Inspector as designated under section 12 of the <i>Energy Coordination Act 1994</i>.
	<p>Equivalent Qualifications</p> <p>As of 1 August 2021 the units EA103A - Operation (Electrical) Legislative Requirements and WAE100 - Electrical Requirements were superseded by WAE200 - Electrical Operational Requirements.</p> <p>A transitional period of two years has been adopted, allowing for the acceptance of the following units, for the purposes of the meeting the nominee training requirements until 31 July 2024:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• EA103A - Operation (Electrical) Legislative Requirements; and• WAE100 - Electrical Requirements.

	<p>General</p> <p>The policy does not constrain the Board's capacity to depart from this policy as appropriate to the circumstances of any particular application.</p>
