



COMMON USE ARRANGEMENTS

A Common Use Arrangement (CUA) is a whole of government standing offer arrangement for the provision of specific goods or services commonly used within government. CUAs are aggregated supply arrangements that enable a public authority to source goods or services.

Where a CUA has been established, a public authority must purchase under it in accordance with the relevant Buyers' Guide¹, except where and to the extent that an authorised officer of the Department of Finance, Government Procurement, approves alternative arrangements.
