


Notice for Service Providers- Ardyaloon Community

- The recent State Direction Notice #3 Remote Aboriginal Communities restricts people accessing Remote Aboriginal Communities across WA, including Ardyaloon.
- In addition to the Direction Notice #3, Ardyaloon Inc. Council has rights to put in place additional restrictions to access Ardyaloon community.

Protocol for service providers and contractors:

- Only travel to Ardyaloon when you have given advanced notice of your travel to the community (by email or phone to the community office). ceo@ardyaloon.org.au PH 089192 4930 or CEO Direct 0428471038
- If you are planning to run a program at Ardyaloon, you need to check with Ardyaloon that it will be permitted by Council at this time.
- If you or colleagues are feeling unwell – **DO NOT GO** anywhere near Ardyaloon community.
- When you get to the community you must follow the community's requirements - report direct to the Office electronically by texting arrival details to 0428 471038
- You must follow the directions of the health care professional in the community. They may require you to:
 - (i) have a further health screen
 - (ii) have a COVID test
 - (iii) isolate to wait for results, and/or
 - (iv) leave the community
- Follow your organisation's health/safety plan relating to managing COVID19 in your operations. You must not operate without a COVID19 management plan.
- Use safe behaviours - reduce contact with community members and protect them from the spread of illness (i.e. hygiene and distancing strategies)
