### Strategic ICT Leadership

Members discussed the recommendations of the Public Accounts Committee Report on *Doing ICT Better* as they relate to the Council's Terms of Reference.

# **WA Data Classification Policy**

The policy provides the minimum protection levels required to ensure integrity of government data, and provides consistency in the language and terms used.

Members discussed cross-agency data exchanges and additional security options for 'unclassified' data.

Members supported the need for a Data Classification Policy.

## **GovNext-ICT Benefits Realisation Management Strategy**

Members commented that it will be a complex job to analyse and report on the data collected from agencies. It is therefore crucial that the WA Government recruits the right people for the job.
