Shaping public sector reform

Machinery of government

Stage 1

Announced April 2017, effective July 2017

'First step in driving cultural change and delivering multi-million-dollar cost savings across government to assist with much-needed budget repair.'

'Aimed at creating collaborative departments focused on whole-of-government objectives and delivering services in the most efficient way'

Stage 2

Late 2017 – early 2018

Established April 2017, reported July - Oct 2017

Service Priority Review

Released Dec 2017

Wide-ranging review into the functions, operations and culture of the public sector to *'drive lasting reform of service delivery, accountability and efficiency at a lower cost to WA taxpayers'*

Special Inquiry

Released Feb 2018

Review of former government's projects and contracts focusing on *'decision-making processes, transparency and financial consequences'* and reporting on *'lessons learnt for current and future governments'*

Sustainable Health Review

Interim report released Jan 2018

Final report to be delivered Nov 2018

Workforce

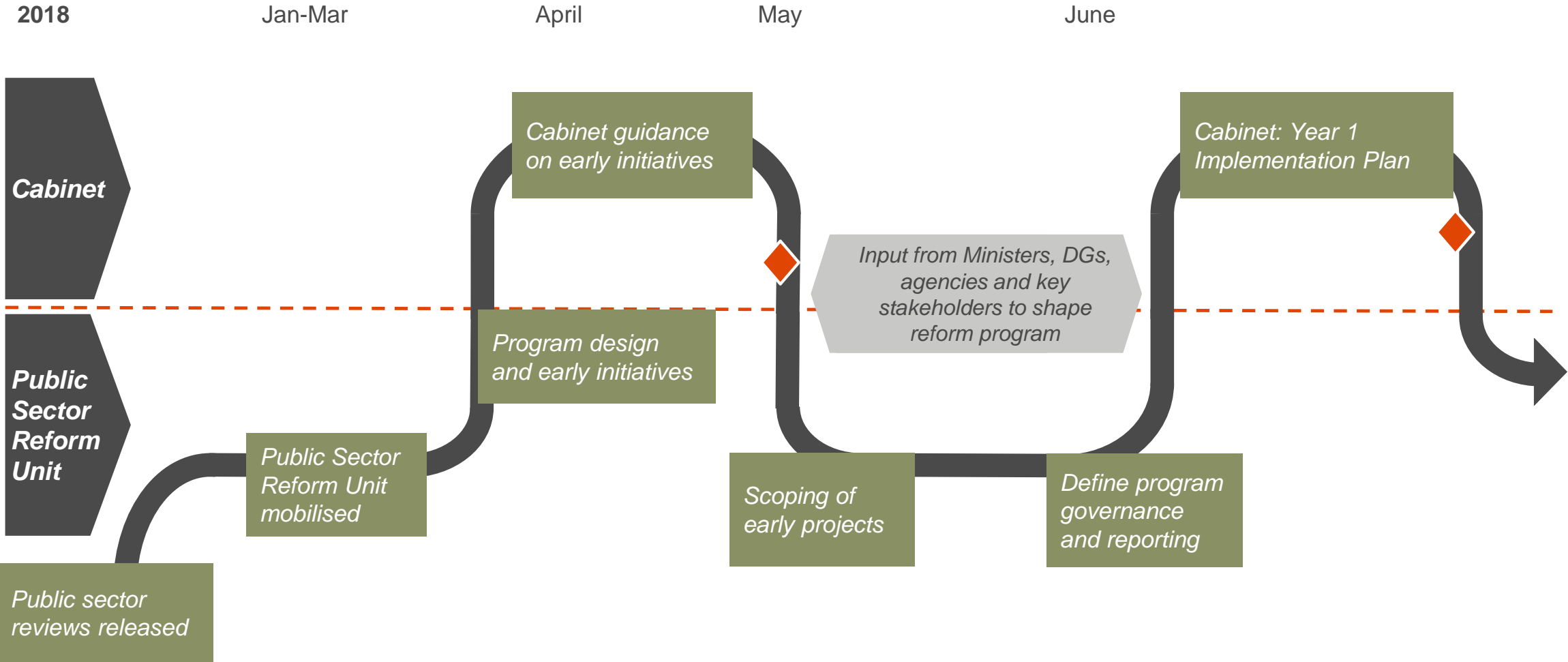
A capable, high performing workforce that delivers on government and community priorities.
