

Outcomes Measurement Framework WA Prototype 4:

The Framework is a hierarchy of outcomes and associated indicators, providing the architecture for a whole-of-government and a whole-of-sector approach to service delivery across agencies and organisations. The intent of the Framework is to orient our focus to the **outcome**, rather than the output; and to the **person**, rather than to the program.

Domains and outcome statements:

- Safe**
 We are, and we feel, safe and free from harm
- Stable**
 We are financially secure and have suitable and culturally appropriate housing
- Healthy**
 We are healthy and well
- Equipped**
 We have the skills, experiences and resources to contribute to our community and economy
- Connected**
 We are connected to culture, our communities, our environment, and to each other
- Empowered**
 We choose how to live our lives



- Sustainable**
 Our built and natural environments are liveable and sustainable
- We have a clean and sustainable environment*
- Our conservation and land management is informed by cultural knowledge, and managed with Aboriginal people*
- We are engaged in actively combating climate change
- Waste generated here is reused or recycled*
- We are adapting to the impacts of climate change
- Increased environmental sustainability and quality
- Our conservation estate increases*
