
THE FLAG OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA

Description -

The flag of the State of Western Australia is the British blue ensign, consisting of a blue flag with the Union flag occupying the upper quarter next to the staff, differenced in the fly or half of the flag further from the staff, by the State Badge situated centrally in the fly.

Specifications for a flag 1800mm in length and 900mm in width -



The diameter of the State Badge is 4/9ths the width of the flag.

The size of the swan within the circle is calculated by taking a centre point (**s**), which is 16.2mm to the right and 13.7mm above the centre of the badge (**b**). Using this centre point and drawing a circle around the swan, the size of the swan circle is 59% of the size of the badge – as illustrated above. (Note: dotted lines are not part of the design).
