


Western Australia

- Seasonally adjusted building approvals increased by 2.3% to 1,655 between December and January 2018
- Approvals fell by 8.8% in annual average terms and dropped by 1.2% over the three months to January 2018.
- Trend building approvals in Western Australia increased by 0.4% between December and January, and fell by 8.0% in annual average terms.

Australia

- Australia's seasonally adjusted building approvals rose by 17.1% to 19,851 between December and January 2018.
- Approvals dropped by 3.6% in annual average terms and increased by 2.3% in the three months ending in January.
- Australia's trend building approvals rose by 0.1% between December and January, and dropped by 4.3% in annual average terms.
- The largest annual average increase in trend approvals by jurisdiction was 27.2% in Tasmania.
 The largest decrease was 43.2% in the Northern Territory.








