Building Approvals, February 2020


Key Facts


Western Australia

- Seasonally adjusted building approvals increased by 6.2% to 1,165 between January and February 2020.
- Approvals fell by 7.6% in annual average terms and grew by 1.1% over the three months to February 2020.
- Trend building approvals in Western Australia decreased by 2.0% between January and February, and fell by 8.0% in annual average terms.

Australia

- Australia's seasonally adjusted building approvals rose by 19.9% to 15,698 between January and February 2020.
- Approvals dropped by 15.7% in annual average terms and increased by 3.9% in the three months ending in February.
- Australia's trend building approvals rose by 1.0% between January and February, and dropped by 15.7% in annual average terms.
- The smallest decrease in trend approvals by jurisdiction was 2.6% in South Australia. The largest decrease was 37.7% in the Australian Capital Territory.
