Building Approvals, June 2020

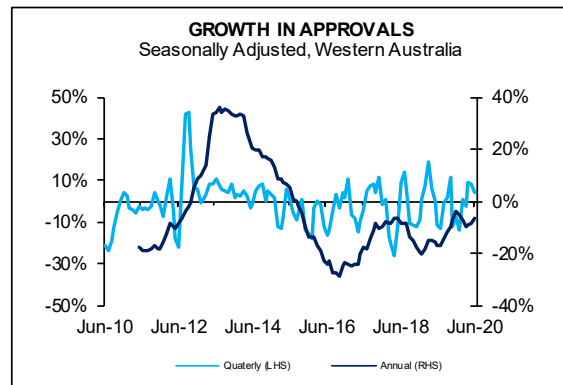
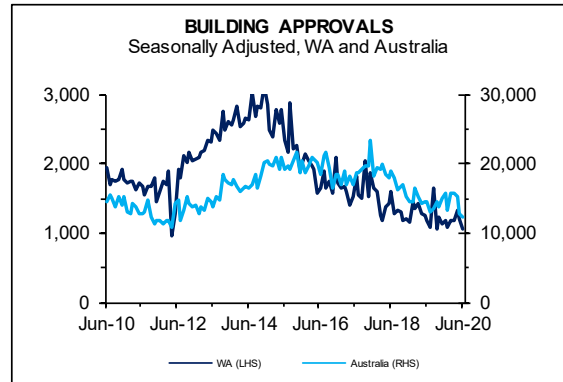
Key Facts

Western Australia

- Seasonally adjusted building approvals decreased by 11.7% to 1,063 between May and June 2020.
- Approvals fell by 6.8% in annual average terms and grew by 3.9% over the three months to June 2020.

Australia

- Australia's seasonally adjusted building approvals fell by 4.9% to 12,213 between May and June 2020.
- Approvals dropped by 9.0% in annual average terms and decreased by 10.0% in the three months ending in June.
- The largest annual average increase in seasonally adjusted approvals by jurisdiction was 7.6% in South Australia. The largest decrease was 18.4% in New South Wales.
