
Key Facts


Western Australia

- Seasonally adjusted building approvals decreased by 8.9% to 1,204 between April and May 2020.
- Approvals fell by 8.5% in annual average terms and grew by 8.1% over the three months to May 2020.

Australia

- Australia's seasonally adjusted building approvals fell by 16.4% to 12,736 between April and May 2020.
- Approvals dropped by 10.1% in annual average terms and decreased by 2.8% in the three months ending in May.
- The largest annual average increase in seasonally adjusted approvals by jurisdiction was 5.4% in South Australia. The largest decrease was 18.5% in New South Wales.
