







Sponsor Application Fact Sheet

Thank you for your interest in becoming a sponsor under the Work and Development Permit (WDP) Scheme. The following is a summary of required supporting information and documentation needed to successfully complete your application.

Organisations, Government and Individuals – Application Requirements

- 1. Completed application form which may require:
 - a. An ABN.
 - b. Information relating to relevant experience, vocational or tertiary qualifications.
 - c. If educational/vocational or life skills courses are to be provided by your organisation, please provide details of the courses offered or run by your organisation.
- 2. Relevant insurance documents:
 - a. This varies based upon activities to be provided; please see below.

Health practitioners – application requirements

Psychologists, medical practitioners and nurses who are registered with the Australian Health Practitioners Regulation Agency (AHPRA) are able to apply as individual sponsors under the WDP Scheme. The only documentation required is the completed Health Practitioner Sponsor Application form, which requests that you provide your AHPRA registration number for verification.

What activities can my organisation provide?

Every organisation is different and provides different services and activities. Attached is a summary of each activity in order to ascertain which activities your organisation is able to provide. The qualifications of your staff are also assessed to confirm whether or not your organisation has sufficient staff resources to provide these activities to an appropriate standard.
