Negotiation

- Between generator and Western Power
 - Ideal as a starting point
- Justifiable variations, but not below min
 - Requires AEMO approval



Register

- Western Power develops/maintains
- Contains standards & monitoring plan on which compliance will be measured
- Generator must notify when registered information changes



Self-monitoring

- AEMO developed template
- Generator submits for approval
- Scope for justifiable variations from template
 - May vary over time



Compliance

- Must report all non-compliance
- Rectification plans with immunity
- Exceptions of serious or repeat breaches
 - Civil penalty provisions
