## **AEMO Implementation Program Activities**


AEMO have undertaken the following activities of its implementation program, including:

- Planning and design continues for the WEM Dispatch Engine (WEMDE) and System Planning projects.
- System development for Constraint Management and Generator Performance Standards (GPS) projects continues.
- Technical Delivery Services Expression of Interest (EOI) released on 18th November.
- RCM Implementation project initiation process commenced.
- Progressed procedure planning and Procedure development activities.
- Onboarding complete for the Change Lead role. GPS Engineers, remaining Developers and Testers to commence in December. Remaining Project Manager recruitment being finalised.
- Program 'Health Check' progressed with Draft report complete (The Health Check is a short/external review of current status and approach to implementation).

- · Onboard remaining program resources.
- Continue project planning, design and implementation activities.
- Assess Technical EOI responses
- Release RFQ for Bids and Offers (WEMDE Work Package)
- Initiate Phase 1 of the RCM implementation project
- Release RFQ for Process/Procedure support and Certification



## **WEM Procedures**

## **Development and consultation approach**

As per previous WRIG discussions, Box 1 Procedures will follow a single phase of development while Box 2 will undergo multiple phases (with consultation at all points):



Key elements of the development and consultation approach:

- ETIU to work with Procedures Owners to develop target dates for consultation
- Presentations and draft WEM Procedures will be developed by Procedure Owners with queries and feedback to be provided back to the specific technical leads/organisations
- Formal consultation/feedback windows will be provided for each WEM Procedure or related document with consideration given to complexity, scale and other WEM Reform documentation out for review – minimum timeframe proposed as two weeks
- Follow up page-turn or deep dive sessions may be arranged based on feedback provided
- Subsequent changes to finalised or approved documents will be managed in the same manner
