WRIG feedback changes

Major feedback I

- Mandatory tests in Appendix B
 - Frequency of testing => frequency of evidence of compliance
 - Frequency at which evidence of compliance is obtained from either mandatory testing and/or other monitoring mechanisms;
 - <u>Clarification:</u> Suggested frequency; Market Participants to propose, in accordance with required principles and factors
 - Rated Maximum Active Power => maximum Active Power specified in the Registered Generator Performance Standard
 - Specified Maximum ambient temperature =>where practicable and must show intention to do so
 - Operating conditions => Operating arrangements with Generating System
- Other clarifications:
 - No requirements for all machines to be tested in the same year
 - Requirements for recording device are set out under 'Testing and Monitoring Regime'



Major feedback II

- Generator Monitoring Plans
 - Changes to an approved Generator Monitoring Plan
 - Notify AEMO as soon as practically possible, submit revision within 20 Business Days
 - <u>Clarification:</u> Approved Generator Monitoring Plan remains in effect until superseded
- Non-compliance
 - Suspected (observation), to be verified by tests until reasonably conclusive
- Mechanisms by which notifications and submissions are made: MPI & Email
- Records to be retained
 - All correspondences => all written correspondences
 - Retention of records 10.1.2(d) consistent with all market information
