

- Bids & Offers work package technical delivery commenced
- RCM Phase 1 requirements backlog and technical elaboration is complete (some RLM/Registrations impacts). Procurement activity has progressed
- WEMDE Commencement of procurement activity for Dispatch Engine critical path items delivery
- Constraints Management, Settlements Enhancements and Generator Performance Standards (GPS)
  projects continue. Commencing service transition and market trial (GPS) activities in the coming
  quarter
- Technical platform (cloud and on-premise) design is approaching completion to support future projects.



# Market Readiness Engagement & Reporting Strategy


