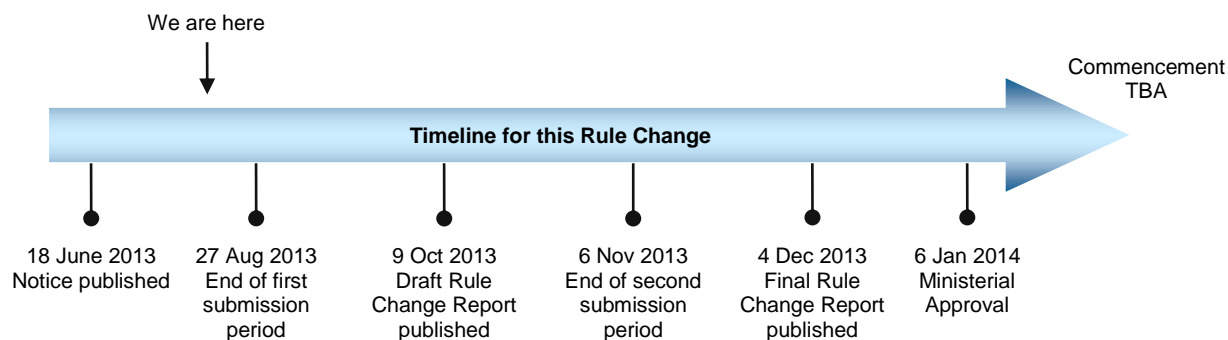
Proposed Work Programme
