Submission

1. Please provide your views on the proposal, including any objections or suggested revisions.

Synergy supports Rule Change Proposal RC_2009_26 and agrees that it should proceed under the Fast Track Rule Change Process.

To ensure an efficient and effective market, the IMO needs to have authority to undertake its role in the Procedure Change Process for **all** procedures, including those developed outside the Market Rules eg those developed under regulations or without a specific Market Rule requiring development.

Specifically, Synergy supports providing the IMO and System Management with the ability to enforce and maintain the following procedures by explicitly referring to them in the Market Rules:

- 1) Data Cleansing Power System Operation Procedure;
- 2) Information Confidentiality Procedure;
- 3) System Restart Power System Operation Procedure; and
- 4) Declaration of Bilateral Trades and the Reserve Capacity Auction Procedure.

2. Please provide an assessment whether the change will better facilitate the achievement of the Market Objectives.

Synergy considers that, by ensuring the IMO has the authority to enforce, develop and amend all procedures, the Market Rules are supported from an operational perspective.
