

NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOP: RELEVANT DEMAND METHODOLOGY

The IMO wishes to inform interested stakeholders of its intention to hold a public workshop to discuss the alternative Relevant Demand calculation methodologies which have been identified for measuring the performance of Curtailable Loads and Demand Side Programmes. In particular, the workshop will discuss the options of utilising a:

- revised static baseline methodology (based on 12 IRCR Trading Intervals), as proposed by the IMO under the Rule Change Proposal: Curtailable Loads and Demand Side Programmes (RC_2010_29); or
- dynamic baseline methodology, as presented by EnerNOC in the Pre Rule Change Discussion Paper at MAC meeting No. 35: Methodology for Relevant Demand Calculation (PRC_2011_01).
