

RULE CHANGE EXTENSION NOTICE

Correction to estimated output of Intermittent Generation for purposes of Appendix 9 (RC_2013_17)

This notice of extension is given under clause 2.5.12 of the Market Rules.

In accordance with clause 2.5.10 of the Market Rules, the IMO has extended the timeframe for the publication of the Draft Rule Change Report by 8 Business Days, until **Monday, 24 February 2014** for the Rule Change Proposal *Correction to estimated output of Intermittent Generation for purposes of Appendix 9* (RC_2013_17).

Dates of the subsequent steps in the rule change process are extended accordingly.

Reasons for the Extension

The IMO has extended the period for the publication of the Draft Rule Change Report beyond the usual 20 Business Days to allow the IMO to consult further with System Management on the required Power System Operation Procedure (PSOP) changes.

The IMO has drafted alternative proposed Amending Rules which rely on the PSOP: Dispatch providing a process for System Management to revise an estimate of the output of an Intermittent Generator where a Dispatch Instruction is issued by System Management directing the Facility to reduce its output.

The extended timeframe will allow Market Participants to consider the amended PSOP: Dispatch prior to the close of the second submission period for this rule change.


Proposed Work Program
