

Rule Change Extension Notice: Removal of Resource Plans and Dispatchable Loads (RC_2014_06)

This notice of extension is given under clause 2.5.12 of the Wholesale Electricity Market Rules (Market Rules).

In accordance with clause 2.5.10 of the Market Rules, the IMO has extended the timeframe for the publication of the Draft Rule Change Report for the Rule Change Proposal: Removal of Resource Plans and Dispatchable Loads (RC_2014_06) by 67 Business Days until **Friday 28 August 2015**. The Draft Rule Change Report was proposed to be released on 26 May 2015.

Dates for subsequent steps of the rule change process have been adjusted accordingly.

Reason for the extension

The IMO has extended the timeframe for the publication of the Draft Rule Change Report by 67 Business Days to allow sufficient time for the IMO Board to consider the Rule Change Proposal.

Proposed work program


• The IMO presents its draft decision in the Draft Rule Change Report.

- The Minister considers the Rule Change Proposal and makes a decision regarding the proposed Amending Rules.
- If approved, the Amending Rules commence.
