Western Power is supportive of the changes regarding the documentation of Meter Data Submission requirements under the Wholesale Electricity Market (**WEM**) Rules, as proposed by the Administration Improvements to Settlement Rule Change Proposal. Western Power is of the view that the Meter Data Submission requirements set out under clauses 8.4.3, 8.4.4 and 8.4.5 of the WEM Rules are operational in nature and should be set out in the Market Procedure: Meter Data Submissions. Therefore, Western Power agrees with the amendment of clause 8.6.2 of the WEM Rules and the deletion of clauses 8.4.3, 8.4.4 and 8.4.5 of the WEM Rules.

Please note that Western Power's submission is limited to the proposed changes to the Meter Data Submission process under the WEM Rules.
