I would like to submit the following suggestion for the committee to consider:

That the voting paper for the Legislative Council shows only the individual names of each candidate as per the current "below the line" system.

That the "above the line" section be deleted all together.

When voting, the elector is directed to number 1 to 12 the preferred candidates in order of preference, and not the entire 56 or so.

The successful candidates would be the first six in order of the number of votes received.

The boundaries and number of representatives should remain unaltered.

The system for voting for the Legislative Assembly should remain unaltered.
