Applications 1/2010 and 2/2010

Applications for review of the decision of the Economic Regulation Authority ("Authority") published on 5 August 2010 to draft and approve revisions of the access arrangement to apply to the Goldfields Gas Pipeline ("Decision") have been made to the Electricity Review Board by BHP Billiton Nickel West Pty Ltd ("BHP") and by Southern Cross Pipelines Australia Pty Limited, Southern Cross Pipelines (NPL) Australia Pty Ltd, Alinta DEWAP Pty Ltd and Goldfields Gas Transmission Pty Ltd (together "Southern Cross"). The applications are made pursuant to section 39 of Schedule 2 to the *Gas Pipelines Access (Western Australia) Act 1998* (as continued in force pursuant to sections 28 and 29 of Schedule 3 to the *National Gas Access (WA) Act 2009*).

Copies of the Decision and the applications lodged by BHP and Southern Cross have been posted to the Authority's website at <u>www.erawa.com.au</u> and can be accessed at that site. Programming orders have been made in relation to the Applications and can also be accessed at the Authority website.

Any person who wishes to be heard in relation to either or both of the Applications must, on or before 10 December 2010, file a notice with the Board that it wishes to make an application to be heard and serve any such notice on the Authority and on each of BHP and Southern Cross. Any such notice should specify the matters in relation to which the third party wishes to be heard and the nature of the interest the party has in those matters. Notices received after 10 December 2010 may not be considered by the Board.
