I, RICHARD CHARLES OLD, Minister for Fisheries and Wildlife, acting in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 9 and 11 of the Act, hereby prohibit all persons from taking all species of coral of the order *Scleractinian* from Western Australian waters within 3 000 metres of the service jetty near the end of Port Street at Port Gregory.
