

**PROHIBITION ON FISHING (BERNIER ISLAND) ORDER 2018**

Order No. 14 of 2018

FD 947/18 [1373]

Made by the Minister under section 43.

**1. Citation**

This order is the *Prohibition on Fishing (Bernier Island) Order 2018*.

**2. Interpretation**

In this order -

*pink snapper* means fish of that common name described by the scientific classification opposite that name in Division 1 of Schedule 7 to the regulations;

*waters of Bernier Island* means all Western Australian waters bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of 24° 40' south latitude and 113° 05' east longitude; thence extending due east along the parallel to the intersection of 24° 40' south latitude and 113° 18' east longitude; thence extending due south along the meridian to the intersection of 24° 50' south latitude and 113° 18' east longitude; thence extending due west along the parallel to the intersection with the high water mark (on Bernier Island); thence generally northerly, then southerly along the high water mark on the northern end of Bernier Island to the intersection with the parallel at 24° 50' south latitude; thence extending due west along the parallel to the intersection of 24° 50' south latitude and 113° 05' east longitude; thence extending due north along the meridian to the commencement point.

**3. Prohibition**

A person must not fish in the waters of Bernier Island during the period 1 June to 31 August in any year -

- (a) for pink snapper; or
- (b) by line from a boat on which any pink snapper is on board, or attached.
