FISHERIES ACT, 1905 – 1975 (Section 12A.) NOTICE.

I, PETER VERNON JONES, being the responsible Minister of the Crown charged for the time being with the administration of the Fisheries Act, 1905 – 1975, acting pursuant to subsection (4) of section 12A of the Act, hereby –

- (a) declare the areas set out in the schedules below to be Proclaimed Fishing Zones from the first day of March, to the thirty first day of May inclusive in each and every year, for the purposes of that Act;
- (b) cancel the proclamation relating to those portions of Western Australian waters in the schedules below published in the *Government Gazette* on May 7, 1965.

Schedule.

- 1. Smiths Beach (FW 361/72): All that portion of the Indian Ocean bounded by lines starting from the high water mark of the southwestern extremity of the rocks situated westerly of a survey post 894.23 metres north and 78.07 metres east of the northernmost nortwestern corner of Sussex Location 602 and extending generally southwesterly along that high water mark to the northwestern extremity of an unnamed promontory situated northwesterly of the westernmost northwestern corner of Location 413 and thence northeasterly to the starting point. Delineated by Lands and Surveys Public Plan 413A/40 A2.
- 2. Cape Naturaliste (FW 140/65): All that portion of the Indian Ocean bounded by lines from a point on the high water mark of that ocean situated in prolongation easterly of the southern boundary of Sussex Location 293 and extending generally northwesterly along that high water mark to the westernmost point of Cape Naturaliste; thence north 800 metres thence generally southeasterly along a line parallel to, and 800 metres northeasterly from the high water mark of the Indian Ocean aforesaid to the intersection with the prolongation easterly of the southern boundary of Location 293 aforesaid and thence westerly along that prolongation to the starting point.
