PROHIBITION ON FISHING (ASHBURTON RIVER) ORDER 1998 Order No. 8 of 1998

Made by the Minister under section 43.

Citation

1. This notice may be cited as the *Prohibition on Fishing (Ashburton River) Order 1998*.

Interpretation

2. In this order-

"the waters of the Ashburton River" means the waters of the Ashburton River, the waters of all of its tributaries and the waters north of the state between 114°54.54' east longitude and 114°55.50' east longitude within 800 metres of the high water mark.

Prohibition on fishing by nets

- 3. (1) A person must not fish for a commercial purpose by means of a net in the waters of the Ashburton River.
 - (2) A person must not fish for a non-commercial purpose by means of a net, other than a throw net or drop net, in the waters of the Ashburton River.
